Dorothy Mullins Memorial Pennies from Your Heart

Throughout February, Open Doors collect pennies and loose change to benefit its projects.

Spring Cleaning Baskets

Cleaning supplies are assembled in laundry baskets for Open Door clients.

Clothing & school supplies are collected and distributed to children for the new school year.
